

Woodlake Lutheran Church Leadership Board Meeting, Thursday, April 10, 2014, 6:30-8:45

Present: Prs Fred Hanson and Diane Roth, Pete Erickson from Interserve, and members of the Leadership Board and the Discernment Team.

This board and discernment team meeting convened on-site at Salem English Lutheran Church, 28th & Lyndale, Minneapolis, for the express purpose of hearing from Pr Jen Nagel and members of Salem about the history leading up to and through their need to totally re-develop the congregation's fiscal, building and mission priorities necessary for survival as a viable worshipping body for outreach for Christ to themselves and the surrounding community.

Salem, through a multi-layered and multi-year process, joined with two other worshipping bodies in like crises, to form a vibrant multi-purpose worshipping community in a renewed setting on the original church grounds. This community is now called The SpringHouse Worship Center, three distinct worshipping communities sharing a building to worship the same Lord and Savior.

The time spent with the Salem group was from 6:45-7:45, with ample Q & A opportunities. From 8:00-8:30 Woodlake's members discussed what was presented, and adjourned with The Lord's Prayer.
